1. Village Enhancement Grant Application.

(a) We have bee allocated £7,900. This is from the Big Lottery Fund for adult exercise equipment in the recreation area, out thanks goes to Ruth Eastham And hazel Warhurst for all their hard work on this, an order will be placed soon.

(b) Other grant applications have been successful we have received £300 from the Strategic fund this will be spent on new lighting for the village hall. An application has been made to HDC Leader Scheme for other village signs, a notice board, and an information panel and some planters. This has been agreed in principle.
