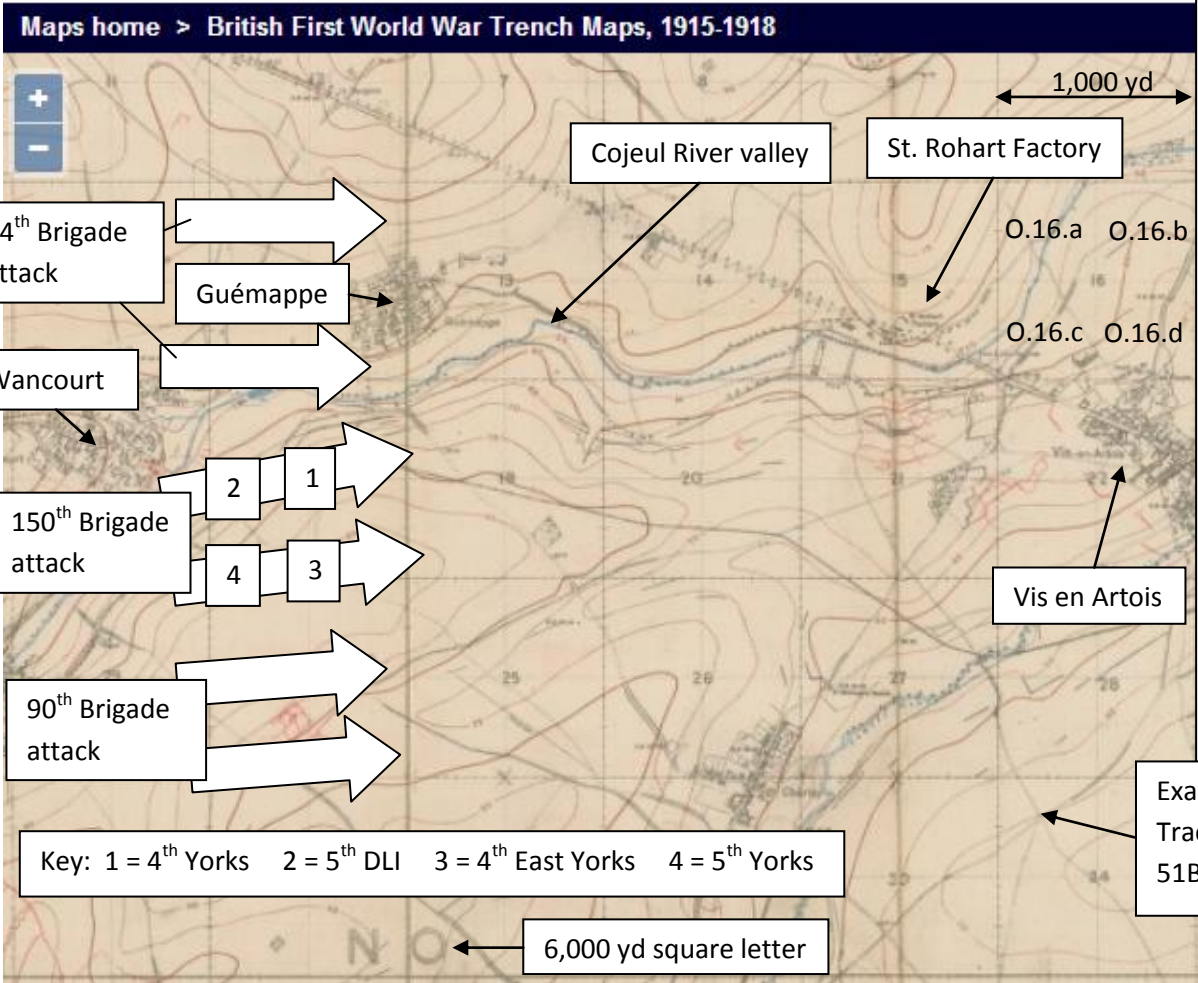
Map number

Each lettered 6,000 yd square has 36 1,000 yd squares, 1-36

Each 1,000 yd square has 4 sub squares, a-d

The last 2 numbers are eastings and northings within the 500 yd square
