

Entry 317 at the bottom of the page:

Stockdale, William, 201837, Pte, A Company, 5th Battalion, Yorkshire Regiment. Captured Arras 23 April 1917. Born 19 March 1895. Next of kin: Stockdale, Ingleby Arncliffe, Allerton.

Et.Kdt. = Rear Echelon Kommandantur (headquarters) Douai.

Limburg an der Lahn was a Mannschaftslager (Enlisted Men's Camp) and held 12,0000 private soldiers and non commissioned officers. It was in VIII Army Corps District (Coblenz). (Source Wikipedia)
