Stockdale, William, 201837, Pte, A Company, 5th Battalion, Yorkshire Regiment. Captured Arras 23 April 1917. Unwounded. Western Front. Born Hutton Rudby, Northallerton, England. 19 March 1895. Next of kin: Mr Stockdale, Ingleby Arncliffe, Northallerton, England.

Friedrichsfeld was a Mannschafslager (Enlisted Men's Camp) and held 35,000 private soldiers and non commissioned officers. It was in VII Army Corps District (Münster). (Source Wikipedia)
